PRESS RELEASE

At the request of many actors and in order to organize transparent elections and ensure equality between all candidates, the Standardization Committee announces a **48 hours postponement of the date of the elections in the divisional Leagues of the FECAFOOT**. Initially scheduled on Friday, November 9, the elections are set to November 11, 2018. As a result, the chronogram of electoral operations revolves around the calendar below:

November 5: 12 noon: Deadline for receiving lists of club representatives

6 pm: Deadline for submission of applications;

November 6 and 7: Examination of candidatures and publication of provisional lists;

November 8: Publication of final lists of candidates after examination of applications;

November 9: Convocation of Elective General Assemblies;

November 11: Elections;

12-13 November: Examination of possible appeals and publication of final results.

Moreover, after examination and exploitation of all the hundreds of requests received following the publication of the successive lists of amateur clubs, the Standardization Committee will publish on this November 2, 2018, the list of the clubs authorized to take part in the elections in the divisional Leagues. That list which has been unanimously adopted by the five members of the Standardization Committee, through a resolution, will be available on the FECAFOOT website at www.fecafoot-officiel.com and will be posted in all the chief towns of Regions where the elections will take place.

In order to give equal chances to all actors, a permanence is opened at the FECAFOOTs' headquarters located in Tsinga Yaounde on Saturday, November 10, 2018.



3 and Sunday, November 4, 2018, from 9:30 min to 15:30 min to receive club delegate mandates and provide all relevant Informations relating to the elections.

The Standardization Committee reaffirms its undeniable desire to conduct the electoral process in the greatest transparency and assures all actors of its neutrality and impartiality.
