## CIRCULAR N°012/FCF/DDF/DC/ACT1/2024

**Subject: Reminder on transfer and registration procedures.**

**Ladies, Gentlemen,**

We hereby inform you that henceforth, national transfers of players on TMS remains obligatory with the following conditions:

- All transfers of players from professional to professional statute;
- All transfers of players from amateur to professional statute;
- All transfers of players from professional to amateur statute;
- All transfers of players from amateur to amateur statute;

Futhermore, this means that for **any** transfer to be done, it must be registered in the TMS system before being forwarded into FIFA CONNECT for the release request following the steps below:

- Submission of the request on TMS with the release of the player under contract attached, for the issuance of a Domestic Transfer Certificate (DTC);
- Submission of the release request on FIFA CONNECT for approval after the issuance of the DTC;
- Inform the General Secretary (by attaching the DTC obtained to request for the online release) if after 72 hours the releasing club has not responded who shall forward it to the competent service for diligence.

For the ongoing football season, **we consequently invite all clubs to obtain their TMS account at the Transfer Service of FECAFOOT.**

We value the strict respect of the above-mentioned prescriptions.

**NB: The generic players used for brevity applies for both female and male gender.**
