On the 12th January 2024, the Conciliation and Arbitration Chamber (CCA) of the Cameroon National Olympic and Sports Committee (CNOSC) was jointly seized in an emergency conciliation procedure by certain football clubs and pseudo football players, represented by Barrister Wamba Makollo, lawyer of the Cameroon Bar Association, seeking, among other measures, by raising impertinent pleas, the precautionary suspension of the President of the Cameroon Football Federation, as well as the current professional championships;

In addition to the fact that the majority of the plaintiffs are clubs whose claims were dismissed on 23 February 2024, it is regrettable to note that their legal standing is questionable. Most of these clubs are in cessation of activities, fictitious or non-existent and are not involved or affiliated in the competitions organised by FECAFOOT. Worse still, they are completely unaware of the existence of this procedure and have never mandated the above-mentioned lawyer to take any action in their names and on their behalf, as illustrated by the complaints lodged with the CCA.

Such an approach is sufficient proof of the unacknowledged and unspoken determination of a group of individuals to harm and damage the brand image of FECAFOOT and above all to prevent its Executive Committee from fulfilling its statutory missions.

FECAFOOT has taken the necessary measures to prevent such acts and reassures those involved in Cameroonian football that it will spare no effort to put an end to the imposture so that no action can tarnish its image or constitute an obstacle to the unreserved desire of the President of FECAFOOT to "restore Cameroonian football to its former greatness".
