The Technical, Administrative and Medical Staff of the Men's 'A' National Team, headed by **Mr MARC BRYS**, Head Coach, was invited today to a working session in preparation for the matches against Cape Verde and Angola scheduled for 08 and 11 June 2024 in Yaoundé and Luanda respectively.

The FECAFOOT President, who initiated the meeting, wished to remind **Mr. MARC BRYS** of the risks he is exposing the national team to, considering the various shortcomings observed:

- 1. The manifest refusal to attend the first working session organised by the Secretary General on 10 May 2024;
- 2. Publication of players' list and organization of a press conference in violation of FECAFOOT procedures;
- 3. Refusal to communicate training schedules;
- 4. Taking isolated work initiatives and disclosing information on players to third parties and the media without prior approval from FECAFOOT;
- 5. Failure to communicate the final list of players selected for matches within the allocated time.

Unacceptable behaviour prevented today's meeting from taking place, particularly the attitude of the Technical Advisor n°2 of the Ministry of Sport and Physical Education, who demanded that the President of the Federation communicate the agenda of the meeting, an instruction he had received from the Minister of Sport, without which the working session would not hold.













The President of FECAFOOT, after firmly reminding **Mr TOLLO** that he had not been invited to the meeting in question, **Mr TOLLO** asked Mr BRYS and his assistants to leave the conference room.

The FECAFOOT President, then reminded the Head Coach that his employer was FECAFOOT and that he would be held responsible for the consequences associated with his shortcomings. Before leaving the room, Mr. BRYS launched into a series of insults and verbal abuse directed at Mr. ETO'O FILS, while reminding him that he is the Head Coach and therefore has the final say.

Mindful of the situation and the deadlines imposed by the regulations and texts to ensure that the aforementioned matches can run smoothly, the FECAFOOT Emergency Committee will meet as soon as possible to take the mandatory decisions.
