## FINAL PRESS RELEASE OF THE EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF FECAFOOT HELD ON 24 MAY 2025 BY VIDEOCONFERENCE

On the twenty-fourth day of May in the year two thousand and twenty-five, Mr. Samuel ETO'O, President of the Cameroon Football Federation (FECAFOOT), convened an Extraordinary General Assembly of the said Federation that was held by videoconference. The following items on the agenda were considered;

- 1- **Verification of the conformity of the convening and composition of the General Assembly with the FECAFOOT Statutes;**
- 2- **Approval of the agenda**
- 3- **Address by the President ;**
- 4- **Appointment of three (03) delegates to check the minutes of the Extraordinary General Assembly;**
- 5- **Appointment of two (02) scrutineers ;**
- 6- **Approval of the minutes of the Ordinary General Assembly of 16 November 2024;**
- 7- **Approval of the annual accounts, after presentation by the Independent Audit Firm;**
- 8- **Approval of the ordinary budget of FECAFOOT for the financial year 2025;**
- 9- **Examination of the situation of an association;**
- 10- **Update on the new FIFA objectives contract;**
- 11- **Update on the transfer of part of the FIFA funds earmarked for projects to those relating to operational costs;**

Participants of the Extraordinary General Assembly were as follows:

Also taking part in this Extraordinary General Assembly were personalities such as **Mr. TJOM Roger**, Deputy Director of Norms and **Mr. YADASSI André**, Head of the DNSOS Discipline and Accreditation Department, representatives of the Ministry of Sports and Physical Education;

**Barister ALIMA NGONO Suzanne**, Court Bailiff at the 4th Office of the Court of Appeal of the Centre and the Courts of Mfou, attended the proceedings and checked the identity of the members present.

49 Members out of 61 convened were present at the said Extraordinary General Assembly by videoconference.

the procedures relating to the declaration of meeting, the rules of convocation and quorum have been carried out and observed in accordance with Law n° 90/055 of 19 December 1990 governing public meetings and events and the Statutes of FECAFOOT.

The quorum having been reached, the General Assembly was able to deliberate validly in accordance with the provisions of Articles 22, 25, 26, 27, 31, 33 and 34 of the FECAFOOT Statutes.

At the end of the discussions on each item on the agenda, the following resolutions were adopted:

#### **Resolution N°1**

The General Assembly unanimously approves the agenda for this extraordinary meeting.

#### **Resolution N°2**

The General Assembly, unanimously approves all the resolutions taken during the Ordinary General Assembly of 16 November 2024 in Mbankomo.

#### **Resolution N°3**

All Members of the General Assembly present unanimously approves the annual accounts of FECAFOOT as at 31 December 2024, audited by NEWKO Audit.

#### **Resolution N°4**

The General Meeting, by a unanimous vote of the members present, takes note of the renunciation by the President of the Cameroon Football Federation, Samuel ETO'O FILS, of all his allowances for the duration of his term of office.

#### **Resolution N°5**

All Members present at the General Assembly, unanimously approves the budget of FECAFOOT for the financial year 2025. 

## **Resolution N°6**

The General Assembly, unanimously approves the amendments made to the contract of objectives of 06 July 2023, between the Cameroon Football Federation (FECAFOOT) and the International Federation of Football Associations (FIFA) which authorizes the President of FECAFOOT to sign any document or contract relating thereto.

## **Resolution N°7**

All Members of the General Assembly present unanimously authorizes the transfer of part of the FIFA funds earmarked for projects to those relating to operational costs.
