FINAL COMMUNIQUE FROM THE ORDINARY GENERAL ASSEMBLY HELD ON 4 JULY 2026 IN WARDA-YAOUNDE

In the year two thousand and twenty-six, and on 4 July, following a convening notice issued by the **President of the Cameroon Football Federation (FECAFOOT), Mr ETO'O FILS Samuel**, an Ordinary General Assembly was held at its headquarters in Warda-Yaoundé, for the purpose of deciding on the follow items on the agenda:

- 1. Verification of compliance of the notice convening the General Assembly and of the composition of the General Assembly with the FECAFOOT Statutes;*
 - 2. Approval of the Agenda ;*
 - 3. Address by the President ;*
 - 4. Appointment of three (03) delegates to review and approve the minutes;*
 - 5. Appointment of two (02) tellers, where applicable;*
 - 6. Approval of the minutes of the previous General Assembly;*
 - 7. Presentation of the FECAFOOT Activity Report;*
 - 8. Update on the renewal of the mandate of the independent audit firm;*
 - 9. Presentation of the consolidated and revised financial statements and the profit and loss account;*
 - 10. Approval of the annual financial statements following presentation by the independent audit firm;*
 - 11. Approval of the ordinary budget and special budgets, where applicable;*
 - 12. Update on the reallocation of part of the FIFA funds initially allocated to projects toward operational costs;*
 - 13. Update on the Code of Conduct for Cameroon National Football Teams, "The Indomitable Lions";*
- Reading of the Final Communiqué.*

The Bureau of the Ordinary General Assembly was composed as follows:

- **President: Mr. ETO'O FILS Samuel**, President of the Cameroon Football Federation;
- **Rapporteur: Mr. MANDONG Isaac Noé**, Secretary General of the Cameroon Football Federation.

The following personalities also took part in the proceedings:

- **Mr. MBENOUN Maurice Désiré**, magistrate and head of the Legal Affairs Division, and **Mr. ATANGANA NTSAMA Simon Pierre Marie**, Deputy Director of Operations and Security, representing the Ministry of Territorial Administration;
- The representatives of the Ministry of Sports and Physical Education, who were summoned, were unable to attend;

- **Mr. ABOUEM A BOULL Julien Serge**, special guest.
- **Barrister TSOUNG Eva-Marquise**, Judicial Officer attached to the 11th Chambers of the Centre Court of Appeal and the Mfoundi courts with offices located on the 2nd floor of the SOUK building in Mvog-Ada, attended the proceedings.

Sixty-five (65) of the seventy (70) members convened were present.

As the quorum was reached, the General Assembly was able to deliberate validly, in accordance with the provisions of articles 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 33 and 34 of the Statutes of the FECAFOOT.

Following the discussions on the items on the agenda, the following resolutions were adopted:

Resolution No. 1

The General Assembly, with the unanimous agreement of the members present, approves the agenda for the present Ordinary General Assembly.

Resolution No. 2

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, approved the FECAFOOT activity report.

Resolution No. 3

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, renews the mandate of the NEWKO Audit Sarl Firm as the FECAFOOT's independent auditor for a period of two years.

Resolution No. 4

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, approves the minutes of the General Assembly held on 29 November 2025 in Mbankomo.

Resolution No. 5

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, takes note of the consolidated and revised balance sheet and profit and loss account of the FECAFOOT for the 2025 financial year.

Resolution No. 6

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, approves the annual accounts of the FECAFOOT from 1 January to 31 December 2025, audited by the NEWKO Audit Sarl Firm.

Resolution No. 7

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, adopts the FECAFOOT budget for the 2026 financial year and validates the expenses incurred since the beginning of the said financial year.

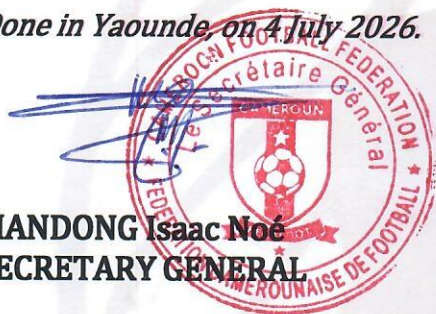
Resolution No. 8

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, authorises the transfer of part of the FIFA funds intended for projects to those intended for operational costs and gives mandate to the President of the FECAFOOT to sign any relevant documents or contracts.

Resolution No. 9

The General Assembly, by a unanimous vote of the members present, adopts the Code of Conduct for the National Football Teams of Cameroon, "**LES LIONS INDOMPTABLES**".
